How to make payments:

Pay in full or in Installments

Full pay and installment arrangements can be made using a secure online payment option that is available 24 hours per day 7 days a week. Payment may be made using electronic check payments or using MasterCard, Discover or American Express credit cards (VISA does not participate in this payment program). There will be a convenience fee of 2.75% charged when using a credit card but there is no fee for electronic check payments. Check and cash payments will still be accepted at the College for the full pay option.

Employer Billing

Provide a signed authorization from your supervisor giving us permission to bill your employer. Payment will be due within 30 days of billing. An employer billing form can be found on our website under Getting Started; How To Register.
